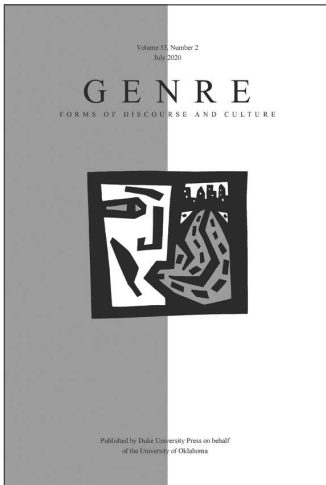
1. Visit dukeu.press/register and register for an account. You do not need to provide a customer number.

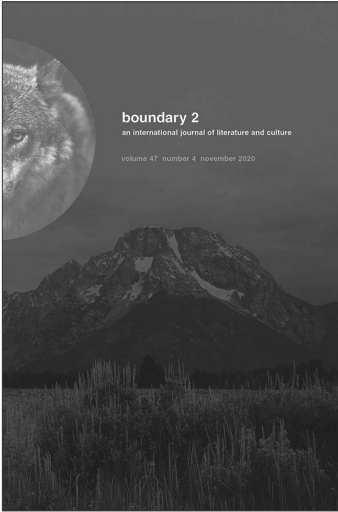

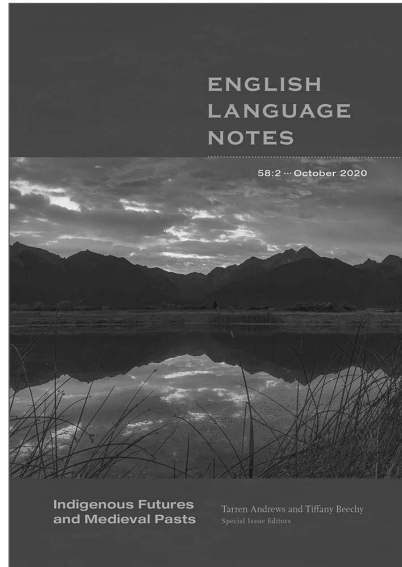
